ORDINANCE NO. 14-70

AN ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO THE REGISTRATION OF SOLICITORS.
BE IT ORDAINED, by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Indiana,
ITEM I SOLICITORS

Section L. Registration Required. It shall be unlawful for any person to engage in business as a convasser or solicitor, calling at residences for the purpose of soliciting orders, sales, subscriptions or business of any kind, or seeking for information or donations without first having registered in the Office of the Clerk-Treasurer. The resistrant shall give his complete identification, his signature, the name of his employer the nature of the products or services in which he is interested, the names of the manufacturers of such products or of the organization which he is representing and the proposed m thod of operation in the City.

Section2. Application. Any person desiring to secure such a solicitor's permit shall apply therefor in writing over his or her signature to the City Clerk-Treasurer on forms provided by the City, and such applicant shall complete all information required on the application, including (1) the name and address of the applicant; (2) the name and address of the person, firm or corporation by whom employed. (3) the length of wervice of such applicant with such employer; (4) the place of residence and nature of the employment of the applicant during at least the preceding year; (5) the nature or character of the goods, wares, merchandise or services to be offered by the applicant; (6) the personal description of the applicant (7) the complete description and license number of the vehicles to be used by such applicant and such other credentials and evidence of the good moral character and identity of the applicant as may be reasonably bequired by the Chief of Police. A fee, which shall be non-refendable, shall accompany each application as follows:

A. For non-residents of the City of Lebanon:

(1) The sum of Twenty-Dollars (\$20.00) for perishable and consumable goods to be offered by the applicant, which whall be valid for a period of one (1) year from the date issued.
