Description of Real Estate

Part of the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of Section 19, Township 19 North, Range 1 East of the Second Principal Meridian, more particularly described as follows, towit: Beginning at a railroad spike set in the centerline of the Elizaville Road at a point 100.00 feet east of the southwest corner of said quarter-quarter section, thence with the centerline of a Driveway by the following courses and distances:

1. North 02 degrees and 41 minutes east 100.0 feet;
2. North 04 degrees and 26 minutes east 60.0 feet;
3. North 14 degrees and 47 minutes east 25.0 feet;
4. North 31 degrees and 28 minutes east 25.0 feet;
5. North 48 degrees and 48 minutes east 25.0 feet;
6. North 65 degrees and 09 minutes east 25.0 feet;
7. North 72 degrees and 28 minutes east 25.0 feet;
8. North 74 degrees and 51 minutes east 25.0 feet;
9. North 74 degrees and 54 minutes east 25.0 feet;
10. North 80 degrees and 27 minutes east 25.0 feet;
11. North 86 degrees and 47 minutes east 28.1 feet;

to a railroad spike in the centerline of said Driveway from which a 12 inch Ash bears north 55 degrees east 33.8 feet and a 15 inch Oak bears south 75 degrees east 40.6 feet, thence south 00 degrees and 40 minutes west 258.6 feet to a railroad spike in the centerline of the Elizaville Road; thence with the center line of said road west 191.66 feet to the beginning, containing 1.016 acres, more or less; the above described real estate being known as Lot Number Seven (7) in "The Woods Sub-Division" in Center Township, Boone County, Indiana, as shown by Plat recorded in Plat Book No. 4, Pages 167-168-169.
