PETITION TO CITY COUNCIL by CITIZENS OF FAIRGROUND ADDITION  
CONCERNING TEMPORARY HOSPITAL PARKING LOT ON CAMP  
STREET

1976

TO THE COUNCIL:

We, the Citizens of this Camp Street Area, petition to our City Council, that they give duly, thorough consideration to the problem arising from the new parking lot on Camp Street.

Point One -- The Alley Situation

This alley is widely used by all six families adjacent to it. All six residents have garages and private parking areas located off of the alley. No city street parking is available for any of the six residents or their guests. To accomodate all residents, the alley must be accessable from both ends.

New commercial and public traffic entering from either direction could produce a traffic hazzard. This problem could be met by closing the alley to through traffic from either direction, with the exepted use of the effected six residents and guests, city utility, and emergency vehicles.

Therefore; We recommend that a, "DO NOT ENTER", sign be posted at both ends of the alley to prohibit traffic, both commercial and public from using it as a throughfare.

Point Two -- The Future

What sound and logical assurance do we have that when the new hospital wing is completed, the Memorial Park will be restored to its original condition as agreed to by the City and Hospital Board, as was reported in The Lebanon Reporter? It is only reasonable thinking that the Hospital Board will always claim the new parking lot to be used as is.

When the County Fair Board presented this land to the City as a County-City Park, it was so written that no commercial enterprize should ever enter this area. The Hospital Board could claim the new parking lot not to be commercial, and would be likely to do so.

Point Three -- A City Beautiful

Commercialism, if not controlled, can tarnish the attractiveness of any city, and destroy the desirability as a nice place to live. We have a very nice, attractive County-City Park. Therefore, let us all put foreward a united effort to keep it thus. This idea should be applied to the entire City of Lebanon.

Lastly, we petition the Council to give the above points due and thoughtful consideration.
