ORDINANCE NO. 32NOTICE TO TAXPAYERS

Taxpayers of the City of Lebanon, Indiana are hereby notified that the following ordinance will be presented to the Common Council of the City of Lebanon for passage on March 27, 1967, at which time taxpayers appearing shall have a right to be heard thereon.

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE ANNUAL SALARIES OF ALL ELECTED OFFICERS OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA, PAYABLE FROM THE GENERAL FUND EFFECTIVE AT THE COMMENCEMENT OF THE TERMS OF SUCH OFFICERS NEXT MEET SUCCEEDING THE GENERAL ELECTION OF 1967, AS PROVIDED FOR BY CHAPTER 107 OF THE ACTS OF 1959.
