This information should be supplied prior to the BOW meeting so the board can make a decision on the Value. You must show company if trading in for replacement. If out right sale company or person. No exceptions.

The board will work with the departments to arrange disposal of equipment.

This makes the whole process fair with transparency and accountability for disposal of surplus Equipment.
